White Zirconia Dental Crowns. An older child may be more sensitive about their appearance and may not be comfortable with a stainless-steel crown that is easily visible in their smile. If this is the case for your child, our pediatric dentists, Dr. Conway Jensen and Dr. Brian Jochim, may recommend a white zirconia crown to repair your child's tooth.
