Family Instability and Child Well-Being

Data from the 1999 National Survey of America's Families (N = 35,938) were used to examine the relationship between family structure and child well-being. I extended prior research by including children in two-biological-parent cohabiting families, as well as cohabiting stepfamilies, in an investigation of the roles of economic and parental resources on behavioral and emotional problems and school engagement.

Family Structure and Child Well-Being: The Significance of ...

Several aspects of family life, school adjustment and friendships were associated with both child mental health problems and low subjective well-being. Greater conflict in the parent-child relationship, lower parental awareness of the child's activities and/or relationships, child difficulties adjusting to the learning and social environment at primary school and the child having poorer quality friendships were associated with both high levels of behavioural and emotional problems, and with ...
