The spinning wheel uses a piece of card on a split pin making it easy to spin around to display each group and their literacy stations for the day. In my Year 2 class, I had 6 groups and planned for 6 activities a week (3 days of 2 rotations). Each rotation lasted approximately 20 minutes with 10 minutes for transition and feedback.
