What is a right hemispheric stroke? A stroke occurs when blood cannot flow to your brain. The right side (hemisphere) of your brain controls the left side of your body. It may also affect your speech and language abilities. What causes a right hemispheric stroke? Ischemic stroke: An artery to your brain gets blocked, usually by a blood clot. The clot stops blood and oxygen from reaching your brain.

Unilateral Neglect: Mostly prominent in right-brain affected stroke patients, Unilateral Neglect (or Hemispatial Neglect) refers to an unawareness of objects to one side of the body or personal space. In severe cases, a side can be completely ignored when carrying out certain tasks and everyday functions.

The two main types of stroke are ischemic, which is caused by an interruption in the brain's blood flow, and hemorrhagic, which is caused by blood leaking into the brain. The way a stroke affects someone depends largely on where in the brain the stroke takes place. The motor control areas of the brain affect the opposite side of the body, so the effects of right hemisphere stroke will affect the left side of the body.

## **The Effects of a Right Hemisphere Stroke | Healthfully**

A right-brain stroke survivor may have a hard time with processing information (visual and verbal) and decreased cognitive (thinking) skills such as poor judgment, short attention span, and short-term memory loss. Caregivers can take steps to help stroke survivors deal with limitations of right-brain injury, once their limitations are recognized.

## **How to Better Communicate with Stroke Patients**

Stroke can sometimes damage the parts of the brain that receive, process and interpret information sent by the eyes. This can result in losing half the field of vision - for example, only being able to see

the left or right side of what's in front of you. Stroke can also affect the control of the eye muscles. This can cause double vision.

## **Stroke - Recovery - NHS**

Hemiplegia or Hemiparesis: Impaired Mobility on the Right Side. A stroke on the left side of the brain often results in impairments on the right side of the body. Hemiplegia involves paralysis on one half of the body (in this case, the right half) and hemiparesis involves weakness on half of the body.

## **Left Hemisphere Stroke: Side Effects, Treatment ...**

Right brain stroke is a condition where the blood flow to the right hemisphere of the cerebrum is interrupted. Blood supply may stop when the blood vessel that carries oxygen to the brain gets blocked by blood clots or plaque build up inside the blood vessel.
