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Under these criteria, for a non-Medicare patient, a physician would report loose or foreign body removal using CPT® 29874 Arthroscopy, knee, surgical; for removal of loose body or foreign body (eg, osteochondritis dissecans fragmentation, chondral fragmentation) with a primary service such as meniscectomy or meniscal repair (even from within the same compartment), with modifier 59 Distinct procedural service to indicate the size or separate incision criteria are met.

29875 Arthroscopy, knee, surgical; synovectomy, limited (separate procedure) CPT defines limited synovectomy as a "separate procedure.". Therefore, 29875 should be reported when it is the only arthroscopic procedure performed on that knee. Compartments are not significant for reporting this CPT code.

Manipulation under Anesthesia is a technique for treating stiffness and poor range of motion following total knee arthroplasty (TKA) or knee revision surgery.Stiffness and decreased range of motion after TKA affects approximately 6 to 7% of patients. 1 MUA is a non-surgical procedure performed in a hospital with the patient under general or spinal anesthesia.
